Voting Early In-Person

- Any registered voter may vote early, in person from their vehicle, using the Drive-Up Early Voting Building located in the rear parking lot of the Village Building located at 3910 Old Buckingham Rd. Please drive in from behind the building using the entrance off Tilman Rd (by the ball fields).
- All voters must provide an acceptable form of ID.
- Early Voting will be offered starting September 22nd through November 4th. Details below...
 - The office will be open Monday – Friday, September 22nd – November 3rd from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.
 - The office will be **closed** on Monday, October 9th in observance of Columbus Day.
 - The office will be **open** on Saturday, October 28th from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.
 - The office will be **open** on Saturday, November 4th from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.
 - Saturday, November 4th is the LAST day to vote in person prior to Election Day.
- If you requested to vote by mail and later change your mind; please bring your unmarked mailed ballot & corresponding envelopes with you to surrender in order to vote in-person instead.

Absentee Voting by Mail

Application

- If you have a Virginia issued Driver’s License or State ID, you may complete an absentee application online. Visit vote.elections.virginia.gov/VoterInformation. Follow the prompts to apply to vote absentee by mail.

Deadline to Apply

Friday, October 27th is the last day to request an absentee ballot be mailed to you. You may fax or email the application as an attachment or send it by mail to the election’s office. Applications must be received by 5 p.m. on October 27th.

Submitting Absentee Ballots

- A secure Ballot Dropbox is available 24 hours a day 7 days a week outside of the Village Building (left side facing the parking lot) located at 3910 Old Buckingham Road.
- The ballot dropbox will be available September 22nd through Tuesday, November 7, 2023 at 7 PM.
- Ballots are collected daily.
- Absentee ballots may also be mailed to the Powhatan County Office of Elections / 3910 Old Buckingham Rd, Suite E / Powhatan, VA 23139 and must be postmarked by November 7, 2023. Please use the privacy envelope and the self-addressed stamped return envelope provided for you.

Vote on Election Day: November 7, 2023

All twelve voting precincts will be open on Election Day for in-person voting from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. Please verify your assigned precinct before going to vote. Many voters’ precinct locations were changed during the 2022 redistricting process. Verify your information by going to <https://vote.elections.virginia.gov/VoterInformation/Lookup/status>
